Middleton Animal Control Fees

Annual Dog Licenses

(As required by the Code of Middleton Chapter 107-1 / Administered at the Town Clerk's Office)

- \$10.00 per year for neutered/spayed dog
- \$15.00 per year for unneutered dog
- Late fees: Additional \$10 per dog after June 1st, \$15 per dog after July 1st, \$25 per dog after August 1st

Annual Kennel License Fees

(As required by the Code of Middleton Chapter 107-1 / Administered at the Town Clerk's Office)

- \$15 for up to four dogs
- \$35 for up to ten dogs
- \$75 for greater than ten dogs

Dogs at Large or Loose

(As established by the Code of Middleton Chapter 270-7)

- \$10 fine for first offense
- \$30 fine for second offense
- \$50 fine for third and subsequent offenses

Mass State Law Fines

- \$50.00 for a dog, cat, or ferret not vaccinated for rabies (MGL 140 §145B /CMR 330,321,2.07)
- \$25.00 for an unlicensed dog (MGL 140 § 141)

Kennel Fees at Town Contracted Kennel

(As directed by the Animal Control Officer)

- Quarantine :\$35 per calendar day (Payable directly to the Kennel)
- Boarding Fee: \$25 per calendar day (Payable directly to the Kennel)

Public Kennel Hours for Animal Pickup:

- April – Nov: 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Dec – March: 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Veterinary Services / Fees:
