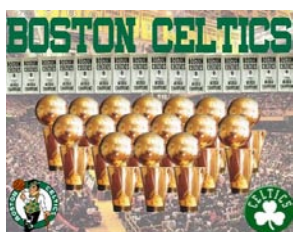


## **BOSTON BRUINS VS. OTTAWA SENATORS**
